Academic German Semester

Study where others spend their holidays!

With the new Academic German Semester the University of Passau is further expanding its strong international and multicultural orientation and opening its doors to foreign students with intermediate knowledge of the German language who are planning on obtaining a degree at the University of Passau or another German university.

The Academic German Semester consists of **two modules**:

- Module I:** Course B2 (intermediate level) with a total of 196 teaching units
- Module II:** Course C1 (advanced level) and preparatory course for the DSH German examination with a total of 222 teaching units (units are 45 minutes in length)



The schedule for the academic semester of 2013 is as follows:

- Module I:** 8 April – 21 June 2013
- Module II:** 24 June – 2 August 2013 and
2 September – 20 September 2013
23 September – 30 September (exam period)

Summer break: 5 August – 1 September 2013

The course participants will take intensive German classes five days a week, taught by experienced lecturers. Extracurricular activities will be guided by tutors who are also available to help the course participants with any questions or problems that might arise.



Registration

You will need to send your application to us in writing. The application deadline is 15 December 2012.

Certificates and ECTS Credit Points

Each module ends with a final examination. Certificates are awarded for successfully completed modules. On passing the DSH German examination a certificate is awarded: this certificate serves as evidence that you fulfil the language requirements for admission to a German university degree course.

In addition, ECTS credit points will be awarded. All courses are taught according to the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)*.
