

Programme Fee

The programme fee is **€3,490** for the whole year, payable in two instalments. For detailed information about payment conditions please consult the application website.

Accommodation

If requested, we will assist participants with finding accommodation in one of the student halls of residence. The rent for a single room with en-suite bathroom/shower and a shared kitchen amounts to approximately €250 a month.

We will also provide a “Mensa-Card” which allows students to buy inexpensive meals (about €5 for a full meal) at the university’s refectory and cafeterias.

Extracurricular Activities

In addition to the German courses participants will be offered a number of extracurricular activities, including a guided tour of Passau, a sightseeing boat trip on the Danube, a visit to an organ concert in the world-famous Passau cathedral, movies, sports, excursions to local businesses and many more...

Study where others spend their holidays!

The new Academic German Year programme is yet another building block of the university's strong international and multi-cultural orientation. It is directed at foreign students with little or no knowledge of the German language who plan to embark on a degree course at the University of Passau or another German university.

The Academic German Year consists of **three modules**:

- Module I:** Courses A1 and A2 (beginner level) with a total of 378 teaching units
- Module II:** Courses B1 and B2 (intermediate level) with a total of 386 teaching units
- Module III:** Course C1 (advanced level) and preparatory course for the German examination DSH with a total of 222 teaching units
(units are 45 minutes in length)



The module schedule for the academic year of 2012/13 is made up as follows:

- Module I:** 1 October – 21 December 2012 and 7 January – 13 February 2013
- Module II:** 14 February – 21 June 2013
- Module III:** 24 June – 2 August 2013 and 2 September – 20 September 2013
23 September – 30 September (exam period)

Winter break: 22 December 2012 – 6 January 2013
Summer break: 5 August – 1 September 2013

The course participants will take intensive German classes five days a week and will be taught by experienced lecturers. Extracurricular activities will be guided by tutors who are also available to help the course participants with any questions or problems that might arise.



Registration

We are now taking applications. You will need to send your application to us in writing. The closing date for applications is 15 July 2012.

Certificates and ECTS Credit Points

Each module will conclude with a final examination. Certificates will be awarded for every successfully completed module. On passing the German DSH examination, a certificate will be awarded: this certificate serves as evidence that you fulfil the language requirements for admission to a German university degree course.

You will also receive ECTS credit points for completing the German course. All courses are taught in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.
