Offers comprehensive support to international academics for organisational matters, immigration formalities and day-to-day life in Passau before, during and after their stay at the University of Passau

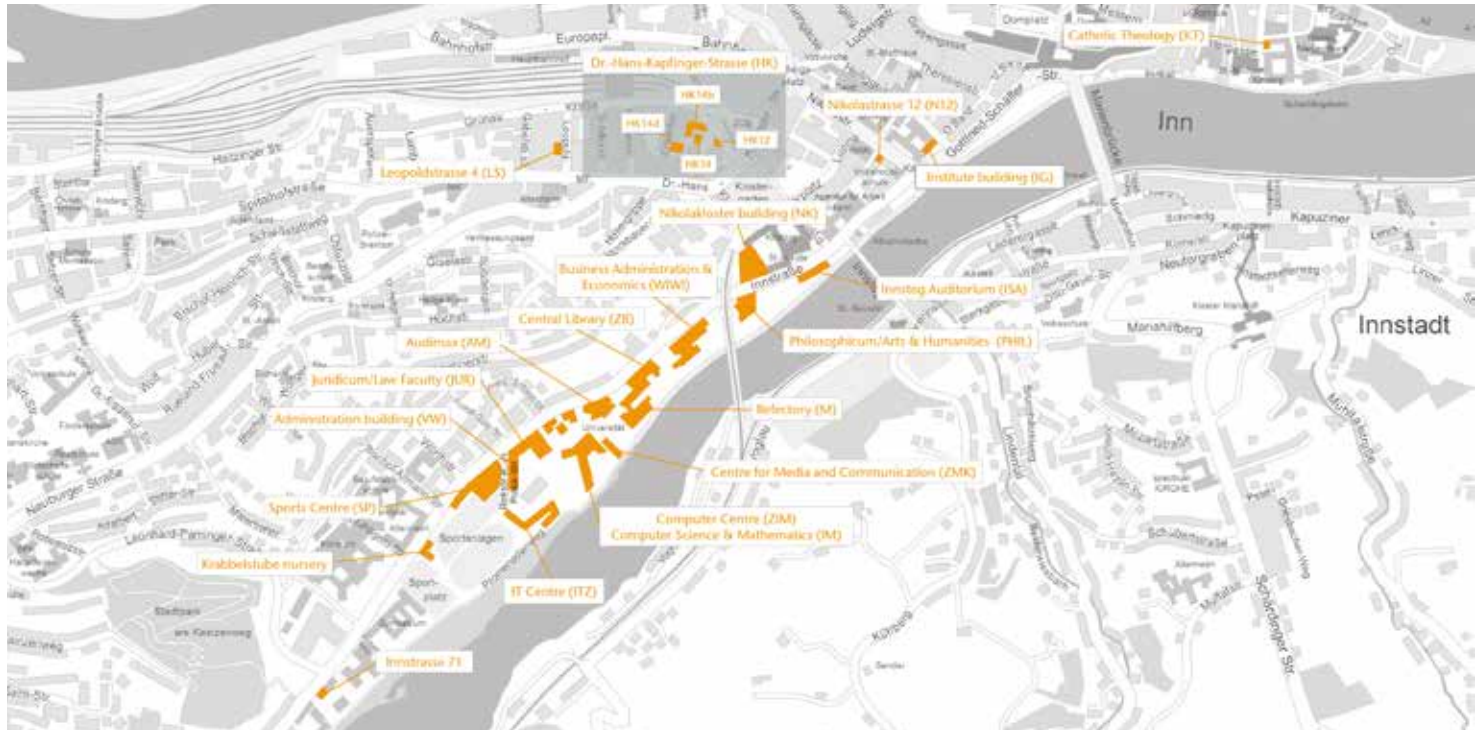
