The 'Welcome to our Campus' leaflet, which is written in English and German, is available at a number of service points and facilities in Passau, and naturally for download online.

'The University has always stood for an organisational culture in which an openness to the world is a matter of course and the integration of international students an overarching aim,' said the Vice President for International Relations, Professor Ursula Reutner, under whose auspices the courses are offered.
