Financial support for language courses Erasmus+



What do we fund?

Under Erasmus+, paid language courses can be funded in the run-up to an Erasmus+ traineeship. The language course is taken at a university or an official institution (at home or abroad) and comprises <u>at least 20 teaching hours</u>. Upon presentation of the certificate and the original invoice, expenses can be reimbursed <u>up to an amount of 500 euros</u>. If an upstream language course is not possible, a fee-based language course that takes place alongside the internship can also be funded. Language courses in the national or working language of the host company can be funded.

What cannot be funded?

In principle, only the actual costs incurred for the language course itself can be funded. Travel costs incurred in connection with the language course (in addition to travel costs to the internship location abroad) must be borne by the scholarship holders. Expenses for tuition fees, visa costs, vaccinations, etc. cannot be covered. Expenses for health and travel insurance must also be borne by the scholarship holders themselves.

How do I apply for funding?

The application for financial support for language courses within the framework of Erasmus+ must be submitted to the Centre for Careers and Competencies of the University of Passau at least <u>2</u> weeks before the start of the language course (auslandspraktikum@uni-passau.de). Alternatively, it can be uploaded directly to the online portal when applying for the Erasmus+ scholarship.

How do I receive the grant?

After submitting the application form in due time, you will receive feedback from the ZKK whether financial support is possible. The invoice for the language course (original) as well as the certificate of successful participation (copy) must be submitted to the Centre for Careers and Competencies at the University of Passau within one month after the end of your Erasmus+ internship stay. Subsequently, the funding will be transferred to the deposited account.
