Gender, Sexuality and Human Rights

Seminar im Wintersemester 2012/13

Auf Initiative der Universitätsfrauenbeauftragten wird im Wintersemester 2012/13 an der Juristischen Fakultät ein interdisziplinäres englischsprachiges Seminar zum Thema „Gender, Sexuality and Human Rights“ als Blockveranstaltung angeboten. Das Seminar steht allen interessierten Studierenden offen.

Seminarbeschreibung:

The course explores the concept of human rights and the international system of protection of human rights through the analytical frameworks of gender and sexuality. It incorporates the knowledge of feminist legal theories to examine the promises and pitfalls of human rights law in a range of selected domains. Its ultimate purpose is to advance the cause of feminism by drawing attention to the universal harms of gender stereotyping. Accordingly, it considers how gender inequality impacts both men's and women's lives and discusses how human rights law can be employed to dismantle the socio-legal construction of gender roles. Examining the two-sided harm enables students to move beyond the terrain of women's rights and to endorse a more comprehensive 'gender-neutral' approach when addressing issues of gender inequality.
