# What is the project about?



On December **15, 2023**, the **Evangelical Student Community** (ESG, organizer) together with **All You Can Do** (AYCD) and the **Catholic Student Community** (KSG) are planning an **international Winter Christmas Festival** in the Nikola courtyard for the second time, during which donations will again be collected for "Bread for the World".

There will be international delicacies, music, drinks from the Gmoa and an intercultural pre-Christmas program during the event.

# What do I have to do?



Together with a team of colleagues you will **plan and design the Winter Christmas Festival from the pre-planning to the assistance on the day of the festival**. It should be colorful and intercultural, you are welcome to contribute your ideas to the project.

## **Team tasks include:**

- Preparation/acquisition of Christmas baked goods in cooperation with international university groups/students
- Design of a framework program
- Cooperation with dance groups/ bands/ choirs etc.
- Purchase/ preparation and serving of soups during the event on **15.12.**
- Decoration assembly and disassembly of the festival/market on **15.12.**
- Assistance during the event on **15.12.**

# How much time do I have to invest?



Time to prepare the event is relatively short, so weekly meetings/updates will be held with the team **starting October 30**. In addition, there will be the tasks of the individual teams (purchasing, decoration, coordination, organization). For the **festival on 12/12** you should calculate a **time slot of around 2pm-10pm/11pm**.

**All in all, you can expect to spend about 35 hours in 6 weeks.**

- Intercultural interest/ideas
- Fun in organizing events
- If applicable, knowledge in the field of design (Canva)
