What is the project about?



Germany's future teachers work in an increasingly globalised environment.

In the context of "internationalisation @home, the Teacher Education Centre (ZLF) & the project global.trex are preparing future teachers for the cultural diversity and internationality of German classrooms.

International experience and intercultural knowledge help them to teach to the best of their ability. However, it is not always possible for all trainee teachers to spend some time abroad. Thus, we provide opportunities *at home* to gain international and intercultural educational experiences, allowing for reflection and placing one's own teaching professionalisation processes in a global context.

In the seminar "Global Classrooms" **individual educational stories** and international backgrounds are shared and viewed through a personal lense and can be experienced and discussed by future Bavarian teachers in a genuine communicative exchange, using English as lingua franca.
