What do I have to do?



The content of the Instagram account must be continued. The first content was already produced in the winter semester 2023/2024.

The idea is to conduct **spontaneous** "**street interviews**" with the most **diverse people in Passau**. The aim is to show that Passau is colourful and presents a variety of interesting people. Many people have special hobbies, interesting stories to tell or simply a special look. The aim is to **tell interesting stories or special features of migrants and Passau residents.** To ask people about their feelings, thoughts, everyday habits, needs, interests and fears in a pleasant, positive atmosphere.

In addition, a **precise concept must be drawn** up as to which specific questions are to be asked in the short interviews in order to find out the personal needs of people from a wide range of backgrounds.

What is it about?



Two semesters ago, the idea of an **intercultural bridge-building centre** was born to build bridges between locals and migrants in Passau, in which people work as trained cultural mediators. On the one hand, bridge builders should be migrants who have been here for a long time and have the same cultural background as the new arrivals. But also locals who are interested in encouraging their fellow citizens to engage in more intercultural exchange. Bridge builders should support, explain, mediate, accompany...

Culturally sensitive provision of information, e.g. on the topics of health, housing, work/ bureaucratic procedures Social integration: culturally sensitive motivation/ "taking you by the hand" for joint leisure activities with
