Cafés and restaurants

When you enter a German restaurant or café, you do not have to wait until the waiter offers you a table. You can seat yourself at any free table you like.

Furthermore, it is totally normal that the bill is split and everybody pays exactly for what they consumed. Not every restaurant accepts credit or debit cards! Ask the waiter before you order if you want to pay by card. Please note also that not giving tips is a big no-no! Only if the service was terrible you should leave no tip at all. In all other cases, a 10 percent tip is normal. Enjoy your meal!
