What is the project about?

With **bilingual readings** we want to give the children with other mother tongues an *empowering* experience and at the same time offer the children with German as their mother tongue an **intercultural experience**.

Our partner Caritas is the largest charitable organization in Germany and organizes the social work of the Catholic Church. The organization is also responsible for 88 daycare centers.

What do I have to do?



- **Look for** short bilingual children's books (possibly from your own home country or your own childhood)
- **Preparation and implementation** of readings with small interludes or pictures from the countries, etc.
- **Discussing** all details with the daycare center management before the event
- **Performing** on fixed dates in kindergardens
