



International Japan-Summer Program 2024



Thank you for your interest in the International Japan-Summer Program (IJP) at Kyoto Sangyo University (KSU). IJP highlights include daily connection with KSU students, level appropriate Japanese language classes and opportunities to learn firsthand about aspects of Japanese life and culture.

Program Content

Dates

- * Arrive June 17 – Depart July 5, 2024
- * Main program from June 18 to July 4, 2024

Japanese Language Classes

Level: JLPT N4/N3 (A2 and B1) levels.
Hours: 3 hours per weekday 09:00 - 12:00.
**Applications from students considered to have a higher or lower level of Japanese proficiency to the levels offered will not be accepted.*

Conversation Partners (CP) & Event Planners (EP)

CP are volunteer students who assist IJP participants with Japanese language study and introduce them to aspects of Japanese life and society. Meet your CP for 30mins each weekday as well as connect with EP through events.

Activities

* Orientation and Campus Tour

Learn more about the IJP program schedule, meet your CP and take a tour of the KSU campus.

* Kyoto City Tours

Choose from a variety of half day and full-day tours with CP and EP as your personal guides.

* Cultural Activities (Subject to availability)

Japanese martial art (Budo), a tea ceremony (Sado) and flower arranging (Kado) or similar activity.

* Visit KSU Classes

Take classes with KSU students to find out more about their learning experience and meet some new faces.

* IJP Only-One-Cafe

Join with other CP and IJP participants for informal chatting over light refreshments at the IOOC.

Textbooks and Learning Materials

Textbooks can be purchased in the first class. Prices will be advised in advance of the program. (approx. 3,000yen).

Accommodation

IJP participants stay in the KSU International House (I-House) dormitory in twin share self-contained rooms. **Rooms** are equipped with a unit bathroom, air-conditioning, clothes washing and drying machines, kitchen with appliances, dining furniture, sofa, desk and study chair, two single beds, closets, and drawers. Cutlery and crockery, pots are also provided for IJP participants. All rooms in the I-House enjoy a sunny south-west perspective with large private balconies.

**Conditions for admission apply. Priority given to applicants on a first in first served basis and those who can be matched with other participants of the same physical gender.*

* *The International House and surrounding grounds are a smoke free zone. Smoking in any form, including vaping, is strictly prohibited.*

IJP 2024 Fee – 140,000yen

*Program fees include tuition, extra-curricular activities and a farewell reception.

*Fees do not include transport to/from KSU or textbooks & learning materials.

*Payment period will be in May. Payment methods will be provided to successful applicants.

*Participation eligibility will be confirmed after payment of the IJP program fee.

*Processing fees incurred during payment should be paid for by the participant in addition to the program fee.

*Cancellation policy: Full refund after payment of fees less costs incurred by KSU at the time of cancellation.

How to Apply

1. Student's home university nominates applicant by e-mailing their name, e-mail address, physical gender and Japanese language proficiency level to KSU by 31 March, 2024.
2. KSU will contact students that can be accepted and explain how to apply.
3. Application documents:
 - Online application form
 - Copy of passport (pdf)
 - Photo (passport photo size)
 - Japanese language proficiency certificate (if available)

Limited to 16 participants.
