#### Introduction

The Intensive Malay Language Proficiency Course at The Institute of The Malay World and Civilization (ATMA) was established as a result of The Consortium of Teaching Indonesia-Malaysia (COTIM) in 1999. From its humble beginnings of only two students from The United State of America, now we have almost 1,000 alumni from all over the world have completed the course at various level. In addition, we also recognized by world prominent universities, as well as La Trobe University, Melbourne (Australia), Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (Japan), and other international bodies, i.e. Korea Tourism Organization (Korea, South), DAIHATSU Japan, and the New Colombo Plan Scholarship Program.

#### 🛞 Course & Duration

KIKBM is a non-degree program course offered in six levels, from novice to advance. Each course comprise 100 hours through teaching and learning method.

- 60 hours focusing on grammar (listening, reading, writing and speaking)
- 20 hours focusing on culture
- 20 hours cultural activities (including workshop, trips and outdoor activities)

KIKBM is conducted by the Malay language native speaker's teacher who will bring all participants through 4 to 5 weeks of intensive learning. Each course can also be tailored according to the needs of students.

In accordance to the current situation, we also offer for online class which is more flexible. Course is divided into two section, 80 hours focusing on grammar and 20 hours focusing on culture.





# 🛞 Fees

The entire course at each level cost are as follow. Payment must be made on the registration day and no refund will be entertained for any withdrawal.





#### 🛞 Certificate & Course Report

All Students will be given a certificate and a report certifying the level, stage and duration of their studies after successfully completing them.

#### Evaluation

An oral and written test will be conducted prior to the commencement of each course to ascertain the students' levels of competency.
