


# Welcome to Sail&Learn, an irresistible blend of education and adventure.

# **CREDITS**


The program is credited with **5 ECTS** points (transferable to other credit systems), with a certificate and transcript of records awarded to participants upon completion.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applications are submitted through the online application form on the program website: <a href="mailto:sailandlearn.org">sailandlearn.org</a>

**Application deadline: 31 May 2024** 

Our team will review your application and get back to you via email regarding the next steps. A detailed program guide and itinerary will be sent to participants one month before the program.

#### **PAYMENT**

Once your application is accepted, you will receive an invoice for the program.

A **25% advance** is required to secure participation. Payment can be submitted in up to three instalments:

**1st - 25% of the fee** - 2 weeks after your application is accepted

2nd - 25% of the fee - by 1 June 2024

3rd - 50% of the fee - by 1 July 2024

#### **TUITION FEE**

Regular: 1790 EUR

Early bird: 1490 EUR (apply by 31 March)

Single cabins are available for an additional fee of 300 EUR.

Please contact us for an adjusted quote in case of booking for groups of 5 or more students.

# CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Participants have the right to withdraw their application at any time before the start of the program. If you wish to cancel, please notify us by email as soon as possible.

Cancellations **before 10 July:** 50% refund of the program fee

Cancellations **after 10 July**: no refund will be granted

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation to the port of departure will be arranged from **Rijeka**, **Croatia**. We will contact participants one month in advance to gather information on their travel plans and provide details about local transportation plans.

We will be embarking from the ACI marina Punat on **Krk island** in the afternoon of 20 July.



#### **PLAN YOUR TRIP**

Rijeka Airport is located on Krk island
(30 km away from Rijeka), but the location
is also easily reachable from several other
Croatian and European airports. Zagreb,
Pula and Zadar (CRO), Trieste (ITA) and
Ljubljana (SLO) are the closest ones.

Numerous international flight connections operate in summer. Please feel free to contact our team for information and travel advice.



#### **VISA**

Students from EU countries only need a valid national ID card or passport to enter Croatia. Citizens of most other countries are required to obtain a visa before traveling to Croatia. Please ensure to check whether you need a visa and start the application process on time.

We are happy to provide an **invitation letter** or other supporting document
needed for visa purposes upon request.

Please note that we can only issue visarelated documentation after the summer
school tuition fee has been paid in full.

#### **INSURANCE**

EU citizens have access to public health services in Croatia with their European Health Insurance Card. Citizens of other countries are advised to book international travel insurance before arrival to Croatia.
