Explanaion of the characteristics

Type of stay abroad

01 Study

e.g. semester stay at university, combined study stay with internship within the framework of Erasmus+

02 Internship

e.g. internship within the framework of Erasmus+, external internship (e.g. company internship), trainee stay, practical semester

03 Other study-related stay

such as a language course, summer school, project or final thesis, internship at a university (e.g. laboratory internship)

Type of mobility programme

01 EU programme (EU-funded, e.g. Erasmus)

All European education programmes, currently Erasmus+ (2014-2020):

- Erasmus+ Study Stays (SMS);
- Erasmus+ Student Placements (SMP);
- EU third country programmes (EU-China, EUUSA, EU-Canada, etc.);
- EU funded scholarships of the National Agency in the Pedagogical Exchange Service (e.g. COMENIUS)

02 Other publicly funded programme (e.g. institutional partnership; non-EU funded)

- Scholarships from state universities (host/home university);
- Scholarships from publicly funded foundations (e.g. Study Foundation, Friedrich Ebert Foundation etc.);

04 No programme, self-organised

- Self-financing, s-called free movers;
- External financing, e.g. by the private sector without a funding programme (e.g. individually granted financial support to individual companies);
- Internships abroad (remunerated or unremunerated) without funding programme
