



Checklist for non-centralised in-person exams

Before the exam:

- Exam venue, time and place number ([Examinations Office website](#))
- As a precaution, we ask you to carry out a self-test, even if your vaccination status is valid.

On the day of the exam and during the exam:

- Masks are not compulsory! We recommend wearing a mouth-nose cover during the exams.
- Dress warm!** The exam halls/rooms have to be aired regularly.
- Items you may bring into the exam venue: identification documents, writing utensils, permitted exam aids, food and drink, personal items in a closed bag, and jackets.
- Smartphones must be switched off and placed in a closed bag** under the desk.
If you pick up your bag during the exam without prior permission from the invigilator and are caught, this will count as attempted cheating.
- Entry to and exit from the exam venue are coordinated: please plan in extra time.
- Only authorised persons may be present; unauthorised persons are prohibited from entering.
- Please do not go to the exam if you feel ill.**
